Steps	<u>Purpose</u>	Key elements	Example
1 - CONNECT	Assure the learner of her/his personal significance and worth	 Reflect on positive actions Reference important personal issues Use <i>Hello</i>, <i>Hi</i>, <i>Greetings</i>, etc. Reminisce about shared experiences Use appropriate emojis 	Hi there, Julie. You nearly scored a half-court three pointer with this assignment – just like Dirk! (Did you see the Mavs game this week?)
2 - ADDRESS	Focus on specific criticisms in the work submission, good and bad performance	 Assess specific requirements Note problems and location in the work Refer to instructions/rubrics Add details whenever possible 	You did a good job with this assignment, covering 8/10 elements (more than required), but there are places where your writing is unclear/confusing (see paragraph 3, sentence 4)
